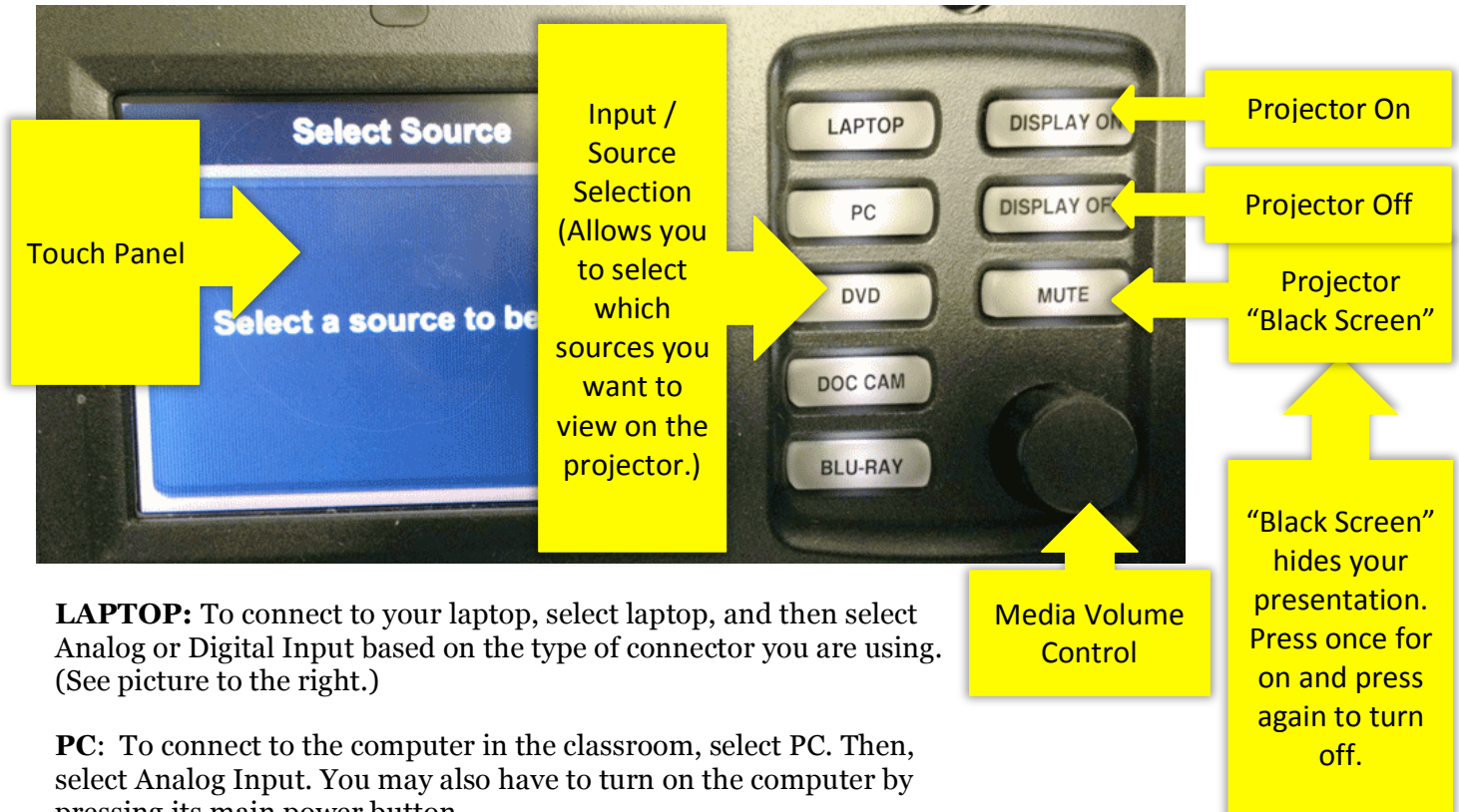

LAPTOP: To connect to your laptop, select laptop, and then select Analog or Digital Input based on the type of connector you are using. (See picture to the right.)

PC: To connect to the computer in the classroom, select PC. Then, select Analog Input. You may also have to turn on the computer by pressing its main power button.

DVD: To connect to the classroom DVD player, press the DVD button. The DVD/VHS unit may be controlled with the touch panel. To access menu functions, press "More."

DOC CAM: To connect to the document camera, press Doc Cam. You may have to also turn on the document camera.

BLU-RAY: To connect to the Blu-Ray player select Blu-Ray and use the remote in the cabinet to control the player.

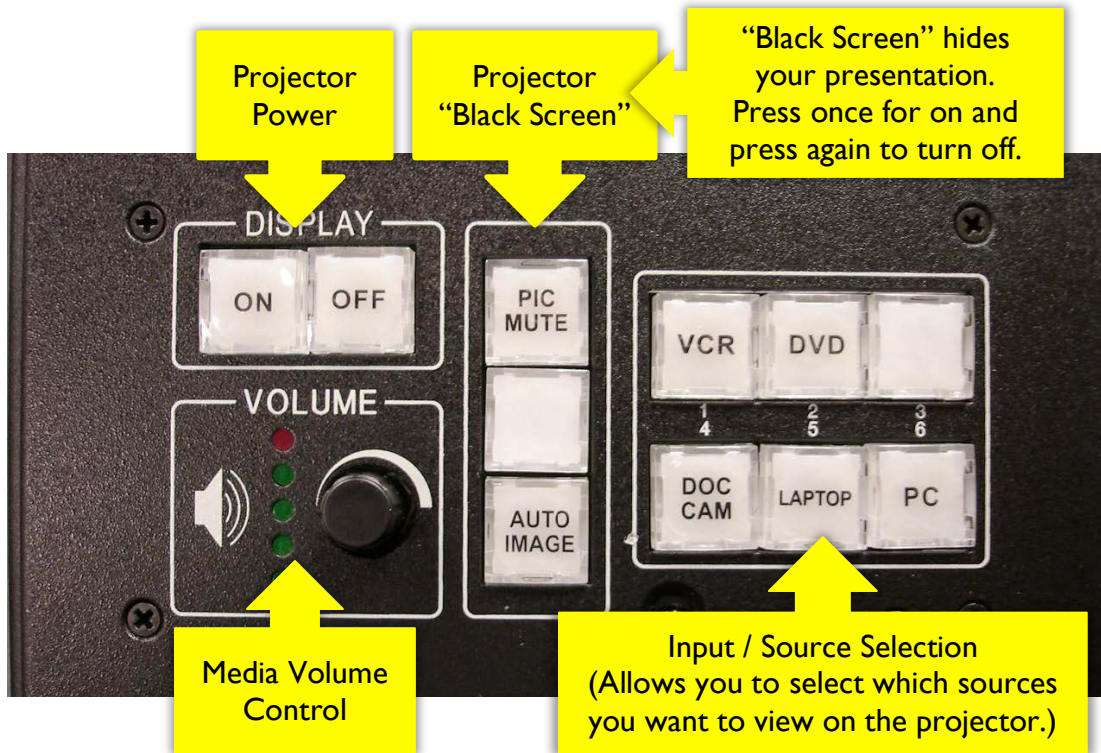

LAPTOP: Use the VGA cable to connect to your laptop and press the Laptop button.

PC: Press the PC button to connect to the computer in the classroom, select PC. You may also have to turn on the computer by pressing its main power button.

VCR: To connect to the classroom VCR player, press the VCR button. To control the VCR player, use the remote in the cabinet or buttons on the player.

DVD: To connect to the classroom DVD player, press the DVD button. To control the DVD player, use the remote in the cabinet or buttons on the player.

DOC CAM: To connect to the document camera, press Doc Cam. You may have to also turn on the document camera.
