ShareLink: The ShareLink allows you to connect your laptop or mobile device "wirelessly" to the display. Select this button and follow the onscreen instructions.

LAPTOP: Selecting the laptop button will route a laptop to the room display. You can connect your laptop using the provided VGA or HDMI cables at the podium.
